Once a student has been accepted, parents will receive an enrollment agreement. The student will be enrolled at The Hill Center when the school has received the completed enrollment agreement and tuition deposit.

The 2009 Summer Program tuition, less the \$200.00 deposit, is payable by June 1, 2009.

The Hill Center operates on a two-payment schedule for the Academic Year Program. The first payment, which is 60% of the tuition and fees is payable by June 30, 2009. The second payment, less the \$750.00 deposit, is payable before November 30, 2009. A 1.5% per month late charge will be assessed on all unpaid accounts.

The school also makes available an alternate monthly payment plan for the Academic Year Program. To participate in this plan, parents must make arrangements with The Hill Center Business Office and receive written confirmation prior to June 15, 2009.

The Hill Center has many expenses of a continuing nature, such as faculty salaries and plant maintenance. In order to plan and maintain these services over the entire year, it is essential that the annual income from fees be assured. For this reason, it is understood that students who are enrolled for the entire program or such portion as may remain after the date of entrance. No reduction or remission of fees can be allowed by The Hill Center for absences, withdrawal, or dismissal. The fact that the school fees for the Academic Year Program are paid in two or more installments does not constitute a fractional contract.

Because of this necessary regulation, The Hill Center through Durham Academy makes available the Tuition Refund Plan - Broad Form which offers parents the opportunity to insure themselves against possible loss of tuition in the event of withdrawal or dismissal. Details of the plan, including cost, will be sent to parents with the Enrollment Agreement. The plan will insure tuition and fees (prepaid and due) in the event of withdrawal or dismissal according to the terms of the policy.

As a member of Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS), the school does provide financial aid for the Academic Year Program to its students and prospective students on the basis of financial need.
